

#### How to get here?

• By train

From REDON station. 14km from the gîte. SNCF - TGV station in Redon www.ter.sncf.com/bretagne www.sncf.com

• By car

1h from Rennes and 1h10 from Nantes. 45 min from Vannes

#### Access by road

By Rennes (N12 - N136 - Exit 8 Porte de Saint-Nazaire - D177- D14)

#### **ARRIVAL IN THE LODGE**

#### Weekdays:

We welcome you to the guest house Le Répit de l'Oust from 4 pm to 10 pm.

At the end of your stay, departure is possible until 10:00 am.

#### The weekend:

Arrival from 16:00 on Friday and departure until 18:00 on Sunday.

On request, a relaxation of these schedules can be granted according to the current reservations.

#### Cleaning, linen and towels

- Bed linen and towels are provided.
- Beds are made up on arrival.
- We only wash the sheets and towels at the end of your stay or at your request.

#### For weekend and holiday bookings:

- A rental contract is set up on arrival. No deposit is required.
- We make our customers responsible according to the clauses of the contract signed beforehand.
- We apply a cleaning fee of 120 euros.

#### Payment of the stay

- On the spot, we ask you to pay the balance of the rent as well as the tourist tax (except if you have booked with Airbnb, Booking or Gîtes de France).
- The authorized means of payment are: cheques, cash, transfers and holiday vouchers.

### THE SPIRIT OF THE HOUSE

#### From the tile workshop to the Gîte, a family heritage transformed...

You have just moved into the Répit de l'Oust and it is difficult to imagine what the building looked like before its renovation from 2019 to 2020.

Here are a few pictures of before



This building dates from the early 1960s and used to be the home of my family's tiling business.

My grandparents created this workshop which was used for storage, mosaic assembly, showroom...

It was a well-known company in the sector thanks to its development and the quality of its craftsmen.

After more than 30 years, the activity stopped and became a shared work space.

For 10 years, creators used the premises: potter, violin maker, ceramist, puppeteer, creative art association, etc.

When I arrived in the commune in 2015, I wanted to enhance this family heritage.

The luthier and carpenter Christian was the last to rent this space. When I told him about my project, he was enthusiastic about taking part.



Together with Tobias, they are responsible for the entire wooden part of the building (frame, framework, openings, etc.).

This construction project has been a great human adventure! We only trusted local craftsmen, most of whom are from Peillac! Many thanks to them.

The Répit de l'Oust gîte has kept exactly the same layout. The layout plans have even been made keeping the original location of the partitions.

In memory of my grandfather Edmond and my grandmother Marcelle, I am proud to welcome you and to offer you this accommodation with a lot of meaning and history!

The earthenware of all the sinks and the listel of each shower were made with old tiles found in the workshop.

Jean-Luc, the company's last tiler and craftsman, certified that these tiles were 50 years old!



The installation was carried out by my father (a former apprentice tiler), whom I thank very much.

#### OUR ENVIRONMENTAL APPROACH

As we are keen to actively contribute to the preservation of the environment, we have built our project with a view to minimising our environmental impact as much as possible.

In order to reduce its ecological footprint, we have set ourselves the following objectives :

- Limit energy consumption and promote renewable energy,
- Optimise water consumption,
- Limiting waste production and ensuring the best possible recovery of waste,
- Promote the use of renewable resources and substances that are less harmful to the environment,
- Promote environmental communication and education,
- Promote alternative means of transport (bicycle hire, etc.),
- Fight against food waste,
- Promote the discovery of local producers.

As part of our approach, we have implemented the following measures:

- Electricity: The gîte has a 100% renewable energy contract
- Energy savings: 100% Led lighting, A++ and A+++ appliances, solar shutters, double glazing and optimised building insulation,
- Heating: A heat pump and radiators with thermostats
- Consumption management: A regular report and monthly dashboard, automatic management of the temperature of the accommodation
- Waste: Provision of sorting bins, composters, reduction of packaging thanks to the purchase of large packages
- Water: Solar collectors for hot water production, water-saving sanitary facilities, water recovery systems for the garden and toilet flushes

We encourage you to send us any suggestion that could contribute to the improvement of our environmental approach.

A questionnaire is sent by e-mail after each stay to collect your valuable comments.

#### Our daily approach

The environmental policy is implemented on a daily basis and is communicated to our customers as soon as they arrive.

An action plan, which can be consulted at reception, contributes to the pursuit of our environmental objectives.

We regularly detect water leaks. Do not hesitate to inform us of any problem so that we can intervene quickly and avoid any waste. A dripping tap drips an average of 4 litres of water per hour or 35,000 litres of water per year!

Water and energy consumption is periodically measured. Our chemical consumption and waste production are also carefully monitored.

In order to ensure that our waste is recycled or recycled in the best possible way, sorting is practiced throughout the establishment (see the waste management section in the welcome booklet). Quality sorting enables waste to be disposed of in an appropriate manner. Hazardous waste is treated in accordance with the regulations.

The consumption of detergents is optimised to limit polluting discharges. For the cleaning of the house, linen and dishes, we favour organic and/or natural products.

Our purchasing policy favours eco-responsible products, designated by official labels as more environmentally friendly. For your breakfast, we offer local and/or organic products. In order to avoid over-packaging, these products are presented in family packs.

Our green spaces are managed in an ecological way. As such, the use of chemical products (fertilisers, pesticides) is forbidden. As we are concerned to contribute actively to the preservation of the environment, we have built our project with a view to minimising our environmental impact as much as possible.

Our gîte is therefore environmentally friendly. So we invite you to keep the good habits during your stay!







#### Other eco-friendly actions

#### Water

Avoid running water unnecessarily. Use the shower sensibly. Fresh water is scarce, let's preserve it!

Flush only toilet paper down the toilet and use the waste bin provided for all other waste.

Use the wastewater disposal points correctly, as toxic and dangerous substances could disrupt the sewage system.

Run machines at full load, adjusting the temperature and cycle according to the actual need.

#### Waste

Limiting the use of over-packaged or disposable products also helps to reduce waste at source.

#### Transport

Choosing fresh produce and seasonal fruit and vegetables reduces transportrelated pollution.

Prefer non-motorised travel over short distances.

#### Food waste

In France, each person throws away an average of 20 kg of edible products per year, of which 7 kg are still packaged.

#### EQUIPMENT LIST AND USE

The electricity meter is in the reception area (white box). Do not touch it. In the event of a power cut, tell Mathieu.

The heating has an "intelligent" setting between 18 and 22°. A mobile box with a sensor is available on the reception desk. With this device, you can adjust the temperature of the main living room. Each room is equipped with individual thermostats.

All the flushes are fed by rainwater recovery (hence its ochre colour sometimes). In the event of a power cut, please call Mathieu so that he can turn on the running water.

You do not have access to the boiler room. If you have any problems, please contact Mathieu: 06 11 13 72 29.

Dishwasher: see the instructions on the top of the machine.

Washing machine: The appliance is equipped with an "auto-dose" system. No washing powder is required as there is a reserve which the hosts take care of filling. All you have to do is choose the programme and start the machine.

Tumble dryer: We recommend using the "cotton eco" programme. At the end of each cycle, please clean the filter and put the dust in the wicker basket. Empty the water tank if necessary (top left)

An internet connection is available in all the rooms of the Gite thanks to the WIFI code:

#### **RULES OF LIVING**

# You have privatized the Lodge and you have signed a contract on your arrival. Here is what this contract commits you to :

- "The Tenant will peacefully use the rented accommodation, furniture and equipment in accordance with the destination given to them by the lease and will be responsible for any damage or loss that may occur during the term of the contract in the premises of which he has exclusive use.
- The Tenant shall maintain the rented accommodation and return it in good condition. If objects listed in the inventory are broken or damaged, the Lessor may claim their replacement value. The cleaning package does not exempt the Lessor from returning the accommodation in a suitable state of cleanliness.
- The Tenant must avoid any noise that may disturb the neighbours.
- The Tenant may not exercise any recourse against the Landlord in case of theft or damage in the rented premises.
- The Tenant shall respect the maximum number of persons that may enter the premises, in accordance with the description that has been given to him.
- The Tenant shall not be able to oppose the visit of the premises if the Landlord or his representative so requests.

#### If you have booked a room, you are obliged to :

- To respect the cleanliness and the equipment provided in the common areas.
- Respect the other guests in the accommodation
- . by not monopolising the spaces and equipment used
- . by being very discreet after 10pm.



Smoking is not allowed inside the gîte.

#### WASTE MANAGEMENT

Sorting instructions are posted at the reception desk and in the back kitchen



Several white bins are available in the storeroom :

- selective sorting (see label above)
- glass
- paper, newspapers
- plastic and cork caps
- light bulbs batteries + electronic equipment





In the kitchen, at your disposal :

- A rubbish bin (under the sink)
- A container for used cooking oil (near the hob)
- A container for chicken waste and another for compost (on the kitchen windowsill)
- (on the kitchen window sill)









Other bins (household waste) are available in the rooms (one in the bathroom and one in the WC)

On the landing upstairs, a yellow bin for waste that can be sorted (see sorting instructions).

We will take care of transferring the bins from the house to the containers in a dedicated room.





• By bike

During your holidays, we can provide you with two bicycles for short journeys (e.g. to go shopping, to get bread, etc.).

If you want to go on a group trip, we have a partnership with a bike rental company, Roul'Vilaine, which can provide you with the number of bikes you need.
